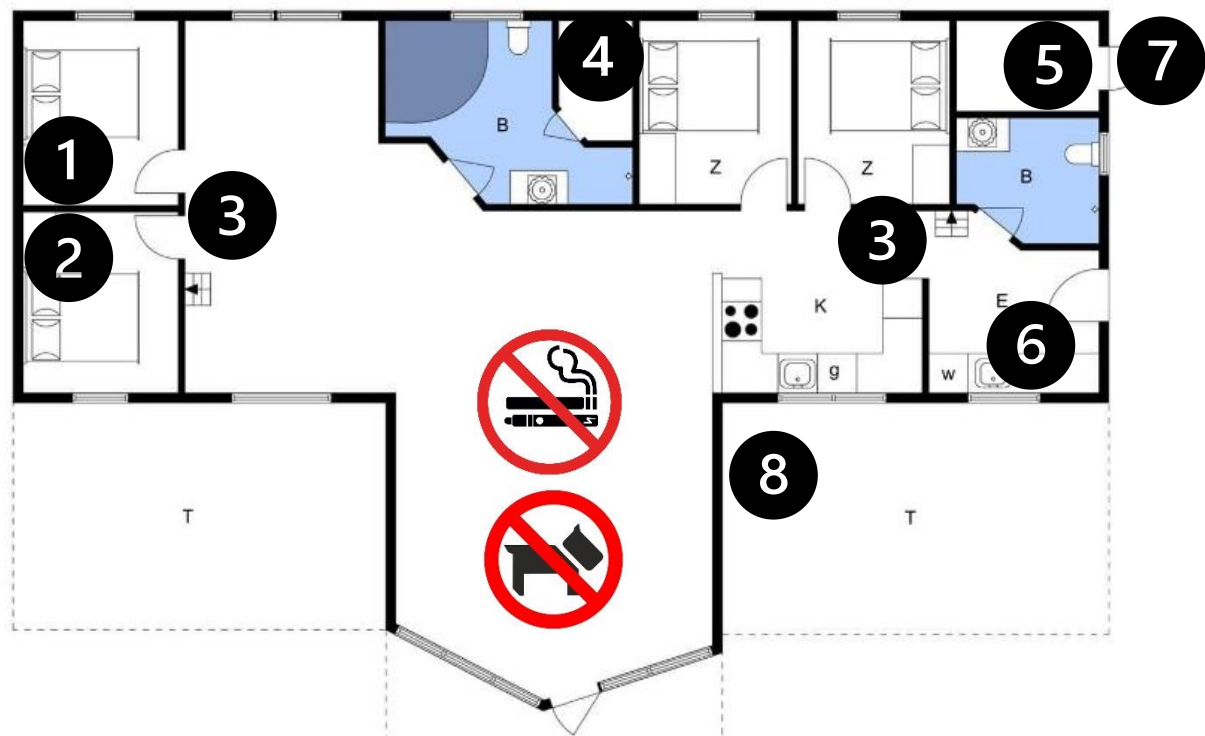

1. In cupboard: Iron, baby chair, baby bed. Behind door: ironing board
2. In closet: Books and games
3. Smoke alarm and carbon monoxide alarm
4. Sauna: Drying rack and floor mop
5. Shed: Fuse board, barbecue, garden cushions, outdoor toys, parasol, fire extinguisher, fire blanket and vacuum cleaner.
6. In cupboard under sink: fire extinguisher, fire blanket, bucket, trash bins for garbage sorting. On the wall: water meter.
7. Gable: Electricity meter and charging stand for electric car (type 2 plug)
8. Outdoor ashtray. Smoking and e-cigarettes are not allowed inside the house.
9. In driveway: recycling containers.



## IP TV


- Turn on the TV.
- Select  
- Select "LG Channels" on the screen (about 300 free channels)

## Satellite

About 420 satellite channels, most are TV, and some are radio.

- Turn on the TV.
- Select 
- Select "Live TV. Satellite" on the screen<sup>2</sup>

## DVD

- Turn on the DVD player.
- Turn on the TV.
- Select 
- Select "HDMI 1" on the screen (use the remote control)
- Pres play on the DVD player.





<sup>1</sup> Provides you have a personal subscription with the respective streaming app.

<sup>2</sup> If it doesn't work, maybe "cable" or "antenna" has been selected in the settings. It must be "satellite" to give you the satellite channels.



## PlayStation 5

### Before use:

- Turn on the PlayStation 5 via the PS button on the controller
- Turn on the TV.
- Select  
- Select HDMI 2 on the television (TV Remote control)
- Log in via:
  - Add user -> sign in (your personal account)
  - Add user -> Quick Play

*Note: Some games require you to create a free account and log in yourself.*

### After use:

- Turn off PlayStation or put it into pause mode after use.
- The power must not be disconnected before the PlayStation 5 is properly switched off.

## Bluetooth speaker


- Connect the power cable.
- Press the speaker button.
- Connect the speaker (ENEBY 2.0) to your device with Bluetooth.
- Press play on your device.
- Adjust the volume on your device and via the button on the speaker.









## Electric car charger (type 2 plug)

### IMPORTANT

CEE socket, electric car charger, oven, sauna, heat pump, radiators, spa, and underfloor heating can potentially have high power consumption. If used simultaneously, this may cause the 25A fuse to trip. This is normal and expected, as there are limits to how much electricity the power grid on the street can supply. The 25A fuse can be replaced at the electrical panel in the shed.

1. Start charging:
  - Unwind the charging cable fully from around the charging station.
  - Remove the cap from the charging cable then connect the charging cable to your vehicle.
  - Start charging by placing the key fob in front of the  symbol on the charging station. The key fob sits together with the house key.
2. Your vehicle is charging.
3. Stop charging:
  - If you use a charge card or key fob, hold it in front of the reader on the station to stop charging.
  - Disconnect the charging cable from your vehicle.
  - Install the cap on the charging cable, then wind the charging cable around the station. Make sure the plug does not touch the ground when stowed.

 <b>LED ring yellow.</b>	The vehicle is fully charged.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stop charging using the same authorization method used to start charging (for example, charge card or key fob).</li> <li>• Disconnect the charging cable from your vehicle.</li> </ul>
 <b>LED ring flashing yellow</b>	Charging session is in queue.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wait. When power becomes available, charging will start or resume and the LED ring will be blue.</li> <li>• You can stop charging at any time.</li> </ul>

## Electric car charger (CEE socket)

The CEE socket is located at the electrical panel in the shed.

The CEE socket shares a 16A circuit with the kitchen. Do not use the oven, microwave, electric kettle, and electric heating at the same time while the CEE socket is at full power.



### IMPORTANT

CEE socket, electric car charger, oven, sauna, heat pump, radiators, spa, and underfloor heating can potentially have high power consumption. If used simultaneously, this may cause the 25A fuse to trip. This is normal and expected, as there are limits to how much electricity the power grid on the street can supply. The 25A fuse can be replaced at the electrical panel in the shed.

## Heating and air conditioning

There is electric floor heating in both bathrooms.

The other rooms are equipped with electric radiators.

The heat pump is installed in the living room and is operated by remote control. The heat pump can be in the following "modes":

- Heat
- Air circulation
- Cooling (air conditioning)

The heat pump is the most economical way to heat the holiday home.



**For your safety:** Avoid covering electric radiators, as this can cause a fire. Never dry clothes on the radiator and ensure that there are no flammable materials nearby.

## Sauna



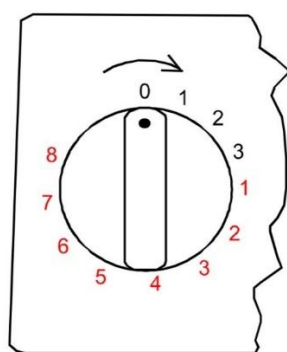
Never cover the sauna heater and avoid pouring water on the heater. This is a dry sauna. Direct water on the heater can cause it to burst and thus be destroyed.

Please always use a towel when sitting or lying down in the sauna.

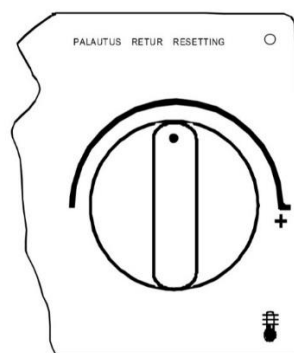
The sauna is operated with timer (left):

- 0 = Off
- 1,2,3 = switched on in resp. 1, 2 or 3 hours.
- The next 1-8 = 1-8 hours delayed start.
- After use: set the timer to 0 to switch off the sauna.

The thermostat (on the right) controls the temperature.

## Hot tub

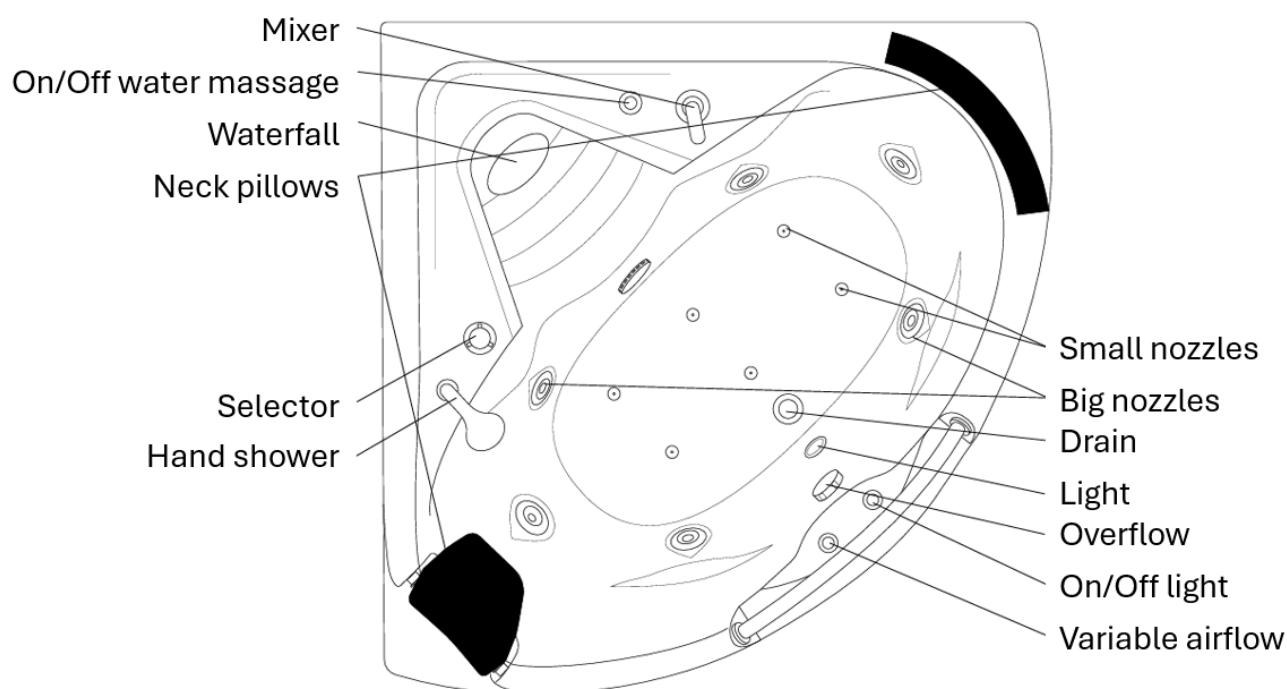
A person who uses the hot tub without first washing with soap pollutes 200 times more than a washed person. It is therefore strongly recommended that you take a shower before using the hot tub.

The hot tub is professionally cleaned after each rental. Special products are used for cleaning, and this ensures a good and clean experience for everyone.

Soaking after use ensures that dead skin cells, bacteria etc. does not dry out and settle in nozzles, pipes and pumps. Therefore, please always leave the spa with the bath water in it after use or expect to be charged an additional 1 m3 of water for extra cleaning after departure.

### Operation of the hot tub

- Fill the hot tub with hot water from the tap.
- The temperature is maintained via the built-in 3kW heater when the water massage is switched on.
- Add one spa tablet per person for optimal hygiene.
- The spa water can be reused the next day if you add 1 extra spa tablet.

## Garbage sorting

Most of your waste can be sorted into the recycling bins located in the driveway (refer to the map on page 4). Any other waste can be taken to the recycling center at Terndrupvej 77, 9460 Brovst.

Lack of sorting results in a 500kr handling fee.



### GLASS

Empty jars and bottles can be taken to the recycling center or placed in the local glass recycling container (refer to the map on page 4).



### BATTERIES AND SMALL ELECTRONICS

Batteries and small electronics can be brought to the recycling center or placed in a transparent plastic bag (maximum 4 liters) on top of one of the recycling bins.



### PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Paper and small cardboard pieces should be dry, clean, and free of any food residue. Please flatten cardboard boxes to optimize space in the recycling bin.



### PLASTICS, METALS, AND FOOD AND BEVERAGE CARTONS

Please rinse out the containers, flatten them, and place them loosely in the recycling bin.



### FOOD WASTE

Food waste must always be placed in a plastic bag. Tie the bag securely and gently put it into the recycling bin.



### TEXTILE WASTE

Textile waste consists of items that cannot be reused by anyone else. Please donate usable clothing to second-hand shops or take them to recycling centers.



### HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous waste should always be taken to the recycling center, preferably in its original packaging.



### RESIDUAL WASTE

Residual waste is what remains after all other waste has been sorted. Dust, waste, and unhygienic residuals must always be placed in a plastic bag.

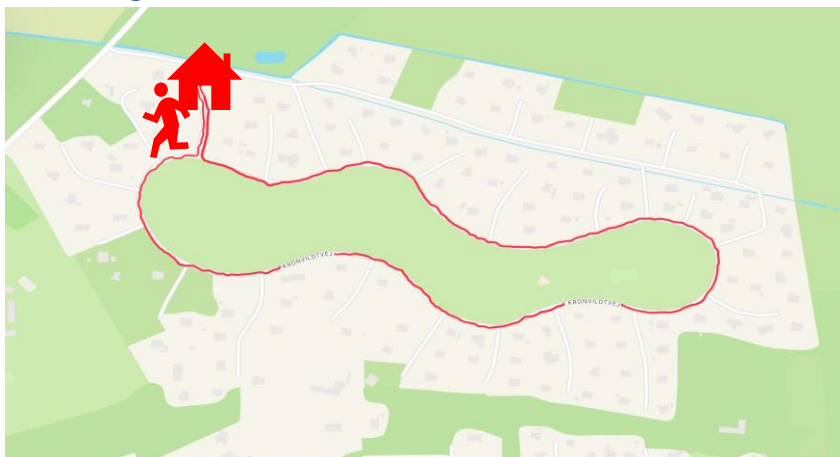

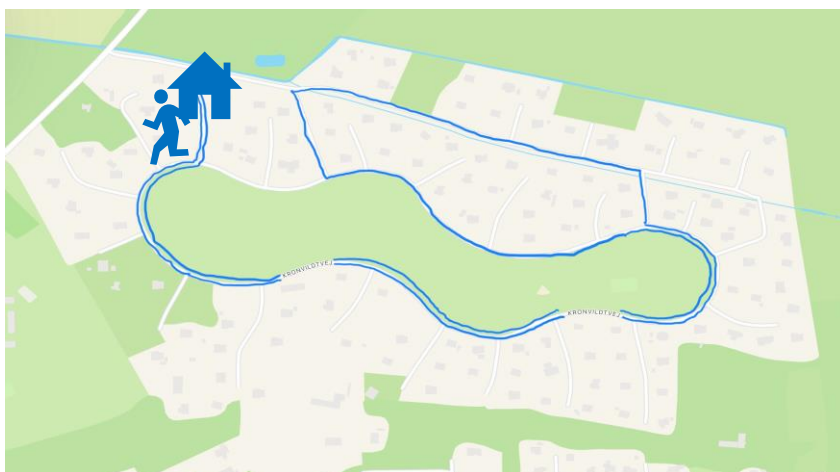
#### 4 Running routes in the immediate area



*Red route: approx. 1.9 km (around the common area)*



*Black route: approx. 2.2 km (a small detour)*



*Blue route: approx. 3.5 km (around the common area and back again)*

If you're looking for an additional challenge, consider running to Trandum Beach and back along the beach road (Strandvejen). This route totals 10 km, and you'll have the chance to enjoy a delicious ice cream midway when you reach the beach.
